From the NORTH (Plainwell, Grand Rapids) or SOUTH (Schoolcraft, Three Rivers) via US-131

Take US-131 to Exit 38 (M-43/W. Main Street). Follow M-43 East/W. Main Street toward Kalamazoo, approximately 4.2 miles. (This becomes Michigan Avenue.) Turn right (south) onto Rose Street. Go two blocks and turn left (east) onto South Street. Follow for two blocks, and the medical school is on the right before the intersection with Portage Street.

From the WEST (Chicago, Paw Paw) via I-94

Take I-94 east to Exit 75 (Oakland Drive). Follow Oakland Drive approximately 3.9 miles and turn right (east) onto South Street. Proceed on South Street about 0.8 miles. The medical school is on the right before the intersection with Portage Street.

From the EAST (Detroit) via I-94

Take I-94 west to Exit 75 (Oakland Drive). Follow Oakland Drive approximately 3.9 miles and turn right (east) onto South Street. Proceed on South Street about 0.8 miles. The medical school is on the right before the intersection with Portage Street.

Conference parking is available onsite and can be validated at check-in. Additional free parking is available on the fifth floor of the Kalamazoo Mall parking ramp, in the WMed designated spaces.

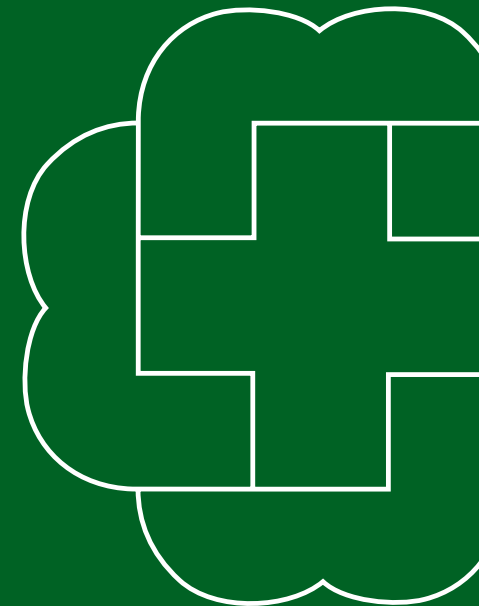
